

Introducing Gatorland's All-New *Gator Gauntlet Zip Line*, the only zip line in the world that is wheelchair accessible...well, as far as we know. So that's our story and we're stickin' to it.

Due to the special nature of this experience and to maintain Gatorland's industry-leading safety procedures, please note the following rules and guidelines:

1. All rules and regulations for our regular zip line apply to the Gator Gauntlet including all riders must wear closed toed shoes (no sandals allowed), no skirts or dresses.
2. **Liability waivers must be completed for all riders. Riders under the age of 18 must have liability waivers signed by their parents or legal guardians.**
3. Riders must be able to transfer himself/herself from their wheelchair to one of Gatorland's chairs in order to properly harness and transport riders to and from the zip line towers. This can be done with the help of their caregiver or guardian. **Gatorland zip line guides and employees cannot assist in the lifting or transfer of guests between chairs.** Once the guest is securely transferred to a Gatorland wheelchair, the zip line guides will insure the rider is properly and safely harnessed for the zip line experience.
4. After the zip line experience, the rider must be able to transfer himself/herself from the Gatorland wheelchair to his or her personal chair. Again, this can be done with the help of their caregiver or guardian, but Gatorland employees are not allowed to assist.
5. Riders must be able to provide some upper body support including some ability to move their torso, pull themselves with their arms, and hold onto support lanyards.
6. Riders must be able to understand and follow simple instructions from zip line guides.
7. Riders must be a minimum of 37 inches tall and weigh less than 275 pounds.
8. **Due to the variety of circumstances that require a person to use a wheelchair, our guides must make judgement calls to insure that the rider is capable of safely handling the ride. As such, Zip line guides reserve the right to make final judgement of a rider's physical capabilities to safely fit into all zip line chairs, harnesses, safety equipment, and ability to safely experience the ride. Our goal with the Gator Gauntlet zip line is to provide this exciting opportunity to guests with physical challenges, but overall safety of our guests is our highest priority.**
9. Advanced reservations for the Gator Gauntlet are highly recommended and must be made in person either at the park, by phone (407-855-5496 ext. 0).

**Due to the additional staff required to perform a zip line ride with a guest using a wheelchair, we may not be able to accommodate "walk-up" requests for guests needing this additional assistance.*
